He works as a daily wager in the city and whatever work he receives, he would do it gladly to get his daily pay. Unfortunately, he was infected with this deadly virus and has been hospitalized to get treated for it. The doctor diagnosed and reported that his lungs have lost the capacity to inhale and exhale the necessary amount of oxygen. Slowly the oxygen level dropped out day by day. The doctor had no hopes for Madhan's uncle (Perumal). As everyday infection rate increased in the hospital, he couldn't afford a bed there. The doctor washed off the hands of the patient. The doctor predicted that he could survive only for two or three days because of the severe infection in his lungs.

At this juncture, our volunteers took VBS to this village from Pulangudi to the little ones to share the love of God with them. It was at this time, we got the opportunity to meet Madhan. He is doing his grade 5. He received the faith that Jesus can heal his suffering uncle. His family members kept on praying to their gods for this man's healing but there was no shade of cure in his body. Finally, after listening to the healing content, this boy sought the favor of Jesus to heal his dying uncle in the hospital. The entire family was in fear because the health workers in the hospital did not allow any visitors and they couldn't see his face for a long time.

Madhan knelt down and started to pray to Jesus for his uncle's cure. The volunteers and the other kids around him joined him in prayer in supporting him and united in heart and mind for his uncle's wellness. The prayers of the kids brought down the winning moment. The next day the doctor could see a hike in the oxygen level and he is in no need of the ICU Incubation.

Some days later, good news came back home that he is recovering and would return home safe. This brought a great joy among the kids and it serves as an encouraging factor for our volunteers and us to move forward into the villages to touch many souls and lend moral support during these hours of the pandemic. When Perumal learned about the tearful prayers of the kids for his

wellness, he was so touched and moved by their love and concern for him, he instantly thanked God for paying attention to the cry of the little ones of his village.

God is well to hear any cry, even if it is from miry clay or a remote village. Madhan is the outstanding witness!
